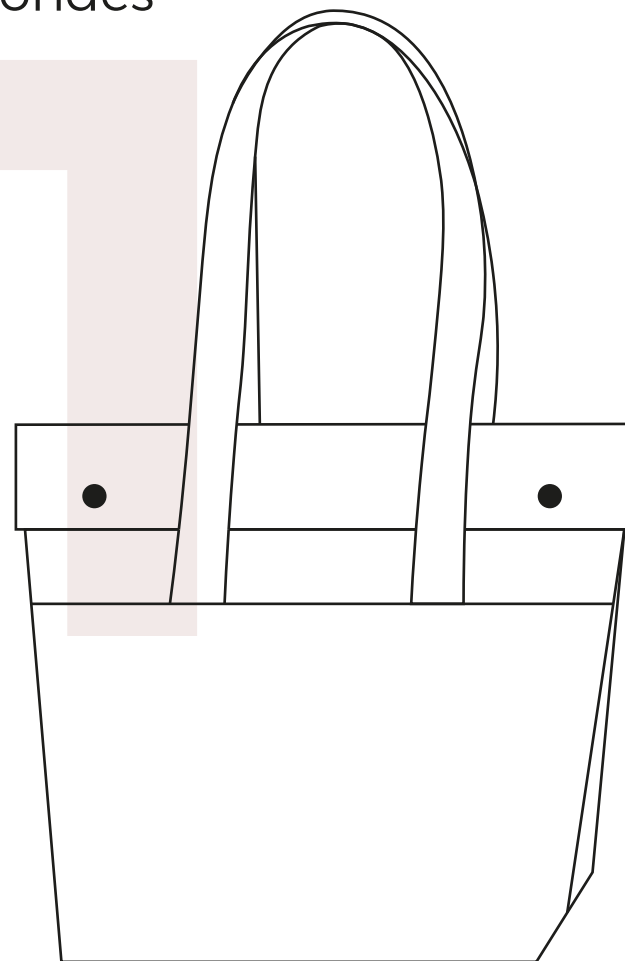
**Para que la bolsa tenga cuerpo lo ideal es entretejar las piezas exteriores o introducir guata/algún otro relleno entre exterior y forro.

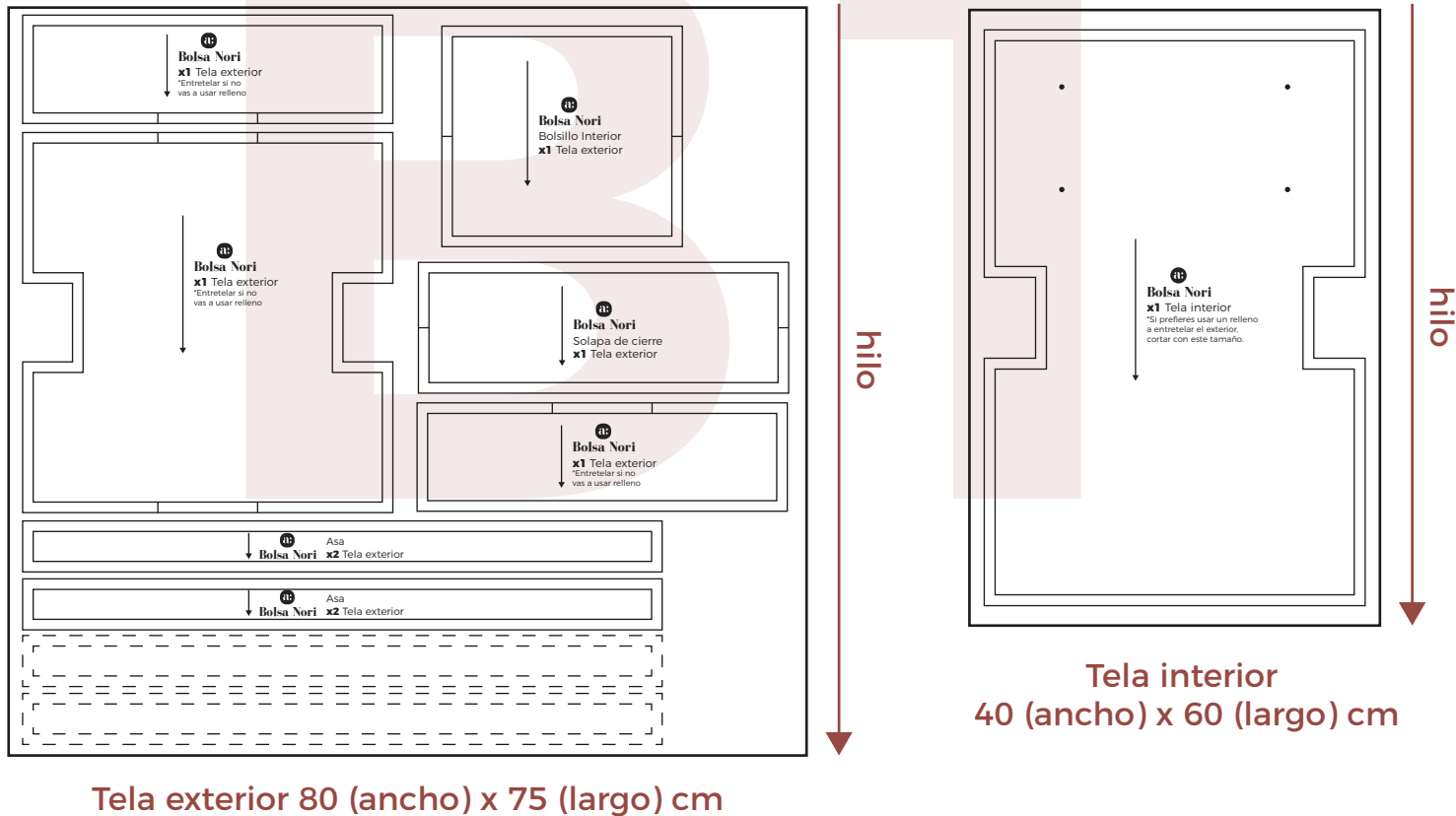

**Los márgenes de costura para todas las piezas son de 1cm.



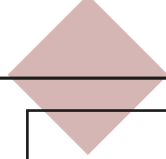
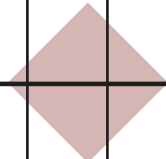
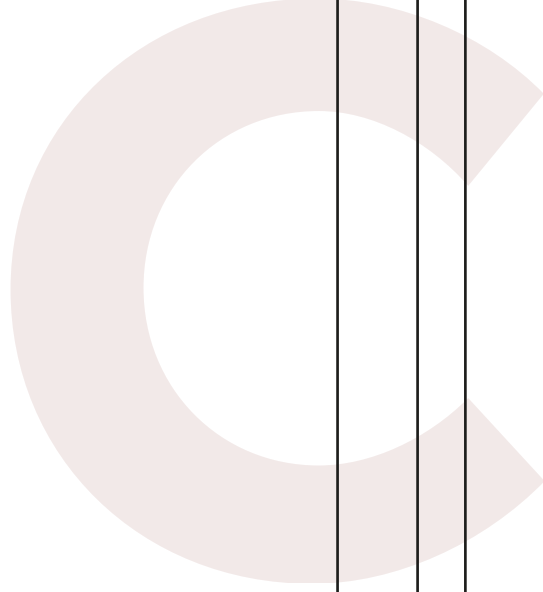
